Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing program prepares nurses with the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary for professional practice in primary, secondary and tertiary care settings. The curriculum includes general education, basic sciences and nursing courses.

Employment Opportunities

Graduates will be capable to work as general nurses in a variety of health settings including: hospitals, communities, schools, nursing homes, home care agencies, research centers, medical insurance companies, industries and agencies for outpatient care among others.

Study Program

The study program is organized in four (4) academics years of 127 semester credits distributed as follows:

- 36 credits in General Education
- 29 credits in Biopsychosocial Sciences
- 62 credits in Nursing concentration

During the first two years general education courses and sciences required for admission are taken. These courses must be taken at any accredited higher education institution. The other two years are completed at the School of Nursing of Medical Sciences Campus for a total of 127 semester credits.

Admission Criteria

Candidates considered for admission are students of units of the University of Puerto Rico System (coordinated transfers or regular transfers) and from accredited private universities (regular transfers). The SON has coordinated transfers with Carolina and Bayamón campuses of the UPR.

Criteria:

- Complete the first and second year requisites before being admitted to the School of Nursing.
- Have a general and specific average of 2.50 or more (The specific average is on the courses of sciences, mathematics and statistics)
- Apply to the program before the due date established by the University.
- Admission interview with the faculty.

Graduation Criteria

- Approve all courses according to the specifications of the Program (127 credits).
- Academic Average of 2.00 or more.
